- Departures by 8 pm Sunday.
- *Please contact us prior to September 5th if you need to arrive outside of office hours. We will do our best to accommodate you. Fees may be charged.*
- Thursday, September 17th is available to those exhibitors traveling 250+ miles. *Any Thursday arrivals must be approved by jandsequestrianevents@gmail.com by September 5th. A \$50 early arrival fee will be charged per horse, plus stall and camper fees. We can not allow any arrivals before 5:00 PM on Thursday.*
- *Any Monday departures must be approved by jandsequestrianevents@gmail.com by September 5th. A \$50 late departure fee will be charged per horse, plus stall and camper fees.*

Fees

- **Class Fees**
 - \$30 for Gypsy, Gypsy Cross & Drum classes

- **Stalls**
Stalls assigned through the show secretary. All manure must be placed in designated areas.
 - \$20 per stall fee will be billed for removal of nails, staples, or any other item affixed to the stall.

 - \$25 daily fee
 - \$60 Weekend (Friday to Sunday)
 - **Horse Stalls**
 - \$30 daily fee

 - **Unstabled fee** (showing from your trailer)

- **Late Entry Fee**
All entries not received as pre-entries by September 5th will incur a \$25 late fee per horse.
- **Campers etc-**
 - \$65 per day per camper (30 electric/sewer/water sites, 100 electric/water sites) subject to change
 - \$25 per day per campsite rental- Infield Only. No utilities. Subject to change.
- **Office fee**
\$15 per horse

- **Payment**

Paypal +4% fee (neghcshow@gmail.com), cash, or checks (made out to New England Gypsy Horse Club). All checks and all payments of any kind must be closed by 3pm on Sunday, September 20th.

- **Refunds**

After September 18th, refunds (minus office fees and stall fees) will be made only if an authentic veterinary certificate or doctor's note is received by the show secretary no later than 8:30 am the day of the show.

***When a check is returned for insufficient funds, or an exhibitor has unpaid show balances or expenses, the exhibitor must reimburse the club for all funds and/or costs incurred *within 5 days* of the initial occurrence and pay a \$25 service fee. If payment is not made within 5 days, the exhibitor will be expelled or suspended by NEGHC and will be considered "Not in Good Standing." GVHS and GHRA will be notified.**

Entry Requirements

- Amateurs must present a GVHS amateur card at check-in.
- A current copy of registration papers must be submitted at check-in for all Gypsy, Drum, and Gypsy Cross horses.
- Liability waivers must be completed with all requested names and signatures and must be submitted with entries.
- **Health Requirements-** Per NYS Equine Health Requirements, the following are required: 1) A current rabies vaccination within the past 12 months. 2) A current, Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA/Coggins) Test in the past 24 months for NYS horses or in the last 12 months for out-of-state animals. 3) Out-of-state horses must have a valid health certificate (valid for 30 days following the date of examination).

Stabling

- Stalls will be given in order of entries received.
- Stall fee DOES NOT include shavings. Shavings can be obtained for \$10 with pre-entries. Shavings can not be ordered after the pre-entry due date but you may bring your own.
- Manure can only be disposed of in designated areas and must remain covered.
- \$20 per stall fee for removal of nails, staples, or any other item affixed to the stall.
- Stalls do not need to be stripped at checkout.
- No one can sleep in a stall.
- No electric heaters or appliances in the barns.

- Directions from Northeast/New England States/New York City Area: Take New York Thruway North to exit 25A, which is I-88. Take I-88 to Exit 22 (the first Cobleskill Exit) Turn left after the ramp and turn right onto County Road 1 (also known as Mineral Springs Road). Turn Right onto Grand Street and Fairgrounds is on the right.
- Directions from Binghamton NY/Pennsylvania: Follow I-88 East to Exit 21 (it is also marked for SUNY Cobleskill). Bear to the left to Route 7. Turn right and follow Route 7 to County Road 1 (also known as Mineral Springs Road) go to Grand Street, turn left and Fairgrounds is on the right.

Overnight Rules

- Permits must be prominently displayed on the windshield of the camper or on trailers with sleeping areas.
- All dry camping (no utilities) must be in the infield. Any individuals camping outside of the infield will be charged the full camper fee.
- All campers and trailers must park in the areas specified.
- All holding tanks must be closed.
- No dumping of wastewater on the ground. There are 2 dumping stations on site.
- No dumping of wastewater on the ground.
- NYS Health Department regulations must be followed.
- The overnight guest is responsible for any violations/fines imposed by the Health Department.
- No one under 18 is allowed to stay in a camper without adult supervision.
- No one is allowed to sleep in stalls.
- A separation distance of at least 10 feet must be maintained between camping units, including any add-on structures attached to the camping units, including awnings and any other structure.
- Charcoal grills, gas grills, or other open-flame cooking devices cannot be used within 10 feet of any camping unit.
- Bonfires or recreational fires are prohibited on the grounds.
- The overnight guest is responsible for any fines or violations imposed by the County Health Department and/or the fairgrounds.
- Overnightriders arriving before or staying after the departing date listed above must be approved by jandsequestrianevents@gmail.com by September 5th. Fees will be charged.

Definitions

1. **Age of Equine** for competition purposes is considered to be one year old on the 1st day of January following the actual date of foaling.
2. **Youth** is an individual who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. A Youth exhibitor may NOT show a stallion in hand, or under saddle, including the lead line, and may not be in a cart driven by a stallion. Youth aged 12 or older may show a weanling colt in hand. No one under the age of 12 may show any horse under the age of three, including leading in a lead-line class. Any Youth exhibitor anywhere on the show grounds while riding a horse is required to wear an equestrian safety helmet that is ATSM/SEI approved. Youth must also wear an ATSM/SEI helmet while driving or serving as a driving groom.
3. **Amateur** - Please see the GVHS rules for more details on amateur status. Every exhibitor in these divisions must hold GVHS amateur status. Amateur cards must be presented at check-in.
4. A **Junior horse (Jr)** is one that is five years or under.
5. A **Senior horse (Sr)** is one that is six years and over.
6. **Open** classes are open to all exhibitors (including youth and amateurs).
7. **Gypsy** Horses must be purebred and are defined in Division Rules.
8. **Novice** is an exhibitor in their first or second year of showing.
9. **Not in Good Standing**: Any exhibitor who fails to pay fees owed to competition management at the time fees are due or any exhibitor who submits a check that is returned for "insufficient" funds or a "stop payment" and payment and any associated fees are not brought current within 5 days is considered Not in Good Standing. Exhibitors not in good standing will become ineligible for awards, membership voting, and other membership benefits until they are paid in full. Exhibitors will not be allowed to participate in future NEGHC shows until payments and any fees are made in full.

General Rules

1. For Gypsy, Gypsy Cross & Drum Classes: GVHS Rules will be used as a guideline. The decisions of the judges/management will be final.
2. Competitors are required to read the GVHS Show Rules before the show.
3. All classes not specified as "Gypsy", "Gypsy Cross", "Drum", or "Gypsy Cross & Drum" are open to **ALL BREEDS**. GVHS, ADS, and USEF rules will be used as a guideline. The decisions of the judges/management will be final.
4. Exhibitors must be ready at the gate and enter the arena promptly. The gate will be closed two minutes after the first call for a missing exhibitor (unless otherwise notified). Exhibitors will not be allowed to enter after the gate is closed.
5. Not all of the Gypsy classes count for each registry. Please check which classes count for your chosen registry.
6. All add slips are due in the Show Office at least 3 classes before the class you are adding.
7. You must notify the office if a tack change is needed at least 3 classes before your class.
8. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the ring steward or show management, who may arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. The ring steward or a member of show management appointed by the ring steward shall be present for all appointments made. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the judge's cards without the judge's permission.
9. **Everyone under 18 years of age must wear an approved helmet while mounted or driving at all times per NYS Law.**
10. The show management or judge(s) may and shall immediately order out of the ring or off the grounds: any person not showing sportsmanship, any person using profane language, any person displaying unsafe behavior and/or any unruly horse, habitual kicker, striker, biter or a horse not under control.
11. Cruelty to or abuse of a horse by any person is forbidden. The judge and/or show management has the authority to dismiss from the class or showgrounds any person for cruelty to, or abuse of, a horse. If a rider is disqualified from showing by the management or by officials, or if a horse is entered and not shown, the entry fee will not be refunded.
12. Lunging and schooling must be kept to designated areas only.
13. No lunging allowed Saturday or Sunday in the arenas. Please use the lunging pad.
14. Horses staying overnight must be stalled.
15. Motorized vehicles are banned in all horse staging, warm-up, and competition areas. Exceptions are made only for show staff and individuals with a documented disability who require a mobility device.
16. No one can sleep in a stall.
17. No electric heaters or appliances in the barns.
18. Exhibitors will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any horse or article owned or exhibited by him/her and shall indemnify the show management and/or NEGHC and/or any agent thereof, against all legal or other proceedings, claims or demands of any kind or nature in regard thereto, or that may arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse or article.
19. No Stallions will be allowed in Leadline, Youth, or Beginner classes.
20. All horses that have a tendency to kick should wear a red ribbon in their tails.
21. All horses shall be show-sound. Any horse showing evidence of lameness or broken wind shall be refused an award or excused from that class and future classes on the same day. The judge has the authority to dismiss from a class any horse that is unsound. Obvious lameness will be cause for

disqualification. Evidence of bleeding, either from the mouth or other areas of the horse, shall be cause for elimination of that horse from that class.

22. Please reference the GVHS Animal Welfare Penalty and Fines List.
23. Any saddle class having more than 20 horses in it must be split and worked in 2 sections, and the top horses in each section are to be reworked for pinning. Beginner and Green classes will be split if more than 14 horses. Any class may be split at the discretion of the judges and/or show management.
24. A horse must be at least 3 years old to show under-saddle.
25. A horse must be at least 3 years old to show in a driving class.
26. Classes should enter the ring at a walk.
27. Being a member of the show committee or on the NEGHC board does not exclude an individual from showing at said show.
28. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule, with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered.
29. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, pandemic, illness, accidents or emergencies.
30. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule as required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein.
31. Classes may be added, combined, split, or deleted at the discretion of Show Management or judges.
32. All dogs must be leashed and restrained. If a dog is found to be unleashed, the owner and the dog may be asked to leave the showgrounds. For safety purposes, it is strongly suggested that no dogs be near or around the show ring, entrance, or exit gate. If a dog is found to be disturbing or dangerous, the owner will be asked to remove the dog from the showgrounds immediately. No fees will be refunded. You MUST clean up after your dog. No dogs are to be housed in stalls.
33. Each exhibitor/horse combination will have a unique number. Exhibitors must display a visible number in all classes. Exhibitors will be given one warning regarding numbers not being visible.
34. Non-showing horses are allowed on the grounds if space is available. The owner must fill out an entry form and pay office and stall fees.

Division Rules

- **Gypsy Division** Horses in Gypsy-specific classes must be full-blood Gypsy and registered with at least one of the following registries: Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (GVHS), the Gypsy Horse Registry of America, (GHRA), the Gypsy Cob and Drum Horse Association (GCDHA), Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA), Irish Cob Society (ICS), or the Gypsy Horse Association (GHA). Proof of registration must be presented with entry forms. All GVHS-registered horses must have GVHS registration numbers on their entry form.
- **Gypsy Cross & Drum Division** Horses must be registered either as a Gypsy Cross, Gypsy, or Drum in GHA, GCDHA, IDHA, TGCA, ICS, or GHRA or in a Gypsy registry. Proof of registration must be presented with entry forms. Horses may cross-enter into both All-Breed and Cross classes.
- **Youth Division** For individuals who have not reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current competition year. A Youth exhibitor may NOT show a stallion in hand or under saddle, including lead line. Youth aged 12 or older may show a weanling colt in Halter. Any Youth exhibitor anywhere on the show grounds while riding or driving a horse must wear an equestrian safety helmet that is ATSM/SEI approved.
- **Green Horse** For horses in their first year of showing.

- **Leadline Division** For riders nine years old and under. Riders of ANY age with special needs are welcome in our lead line division. Exhibitors can not enter any other divisions except for Adaptive. No stallions. The horse must be led by an adult.
- **All Breed** Any horse, regardless of breed, is eligible to participate in these events. If a Gypsy Horse and rider pair are competing in both the All Breed and Gypsy divisions, they must declare at show check-in which division they will earn points toward for show-end and division awards. For example, if a horse/rider pair is entered in both All Breed Ranch Riding WJL and Open Ranch Riding WJL, they must designate which class will count toward show-end and division points. While they may place in both classes, they will only be eligible for show-end and division awards in the declared division.
- **Amateur** Current GVHS Amateur rules will be enforced. www.vanners.org. GVHS Amateur cards will be checked at check-in and are required.
- **Driving** GVHS and American Driving Society Performance rules are used as a guideline.

Class Rules

- Patterns will be posted at least one hour before the class.
- Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (GVHS) rules will be used for all Gypsy specific classes. It is the responsibility of the owner and exhibitor to understand these rules and follow them.
- Note that any riding class not listed as W, WT/J, WT, WJ, or 2 Speed (walk, trot/jog) or WT/J is a three-gaited class.
- In the interest of fair & balanced competition, the same horse/rider combinations can not compete in both three-speed (walk, trot/jog, canter/lope) classes and two-speed (walk, trot/jog) classes. For example, the same Horse/Rider combinations cannot show in both equitation walk/trot and equitation walk/trot/canter. If offered, Pro-Am Challenge, Barrel Racing, Obstacle Challenge, and Versatility Challenge are the exceptions to this rule.
- **Gypsy Champion Halter Classes** First and second-place winners, in each age group halter class, will show for Champion and Reserve Champion. The Champion horse from each gender group will then compete for Supreme Champion. Each judge will award a Supreme Champion.
- **Freestyle & Liberty** *Music must be dropped off in the Show Office upon check-in.* Please list the song and artist on your entry form so that Show Management can prepare. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to test music before the presentation with Show Management and/or Announcer/Music Steward.
- **Disciplined Rail** is a class that tests the skills of both horse and rider, as they execute specific gaits, transitions, and movements as requested by the judge. In this class, competitors may be asked to side pass, hand gallop (in three-speed classes), pivot, back up, lead change (in three-speed classes), extended trot, counter canter, or lope (in three-speed classes), etc.- The class is judged on performance and manners.

Awards

SHOW ENDPOINT TABULATIONS: 1st– 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th– 3 points, 5th– 2 points, 6th – 1 point. ½ point given to an entry that is the only entry in the class. Champion Halter-5 points, Supreme Champion Halter-5 points

GYPSY HALTER AWARDS There will be one Grand Champion, Reserve Champion, and Supreme Champion Horse from each Gypsy sex division *per judge*. The Supreme Champion will be chosen by each judge from the three Grand Champion winners of their respective classes.

HIGH POINT HORSE AWARDS Accumulated by the *HORSE* regardless of the exhibitor. Horses must compete in a minimum of one English, Western and Ranch class to be eligible for High Point Awards. Awarded from the following classes:
